The petitioners' request for bail during the pendency of the appeal before the High Court was rejected.

They were convicted under Sections 8/21/29 of the NDPS Act 1988 and has been sentenced to 14 years imprisonment of with fine. They have already undergone more than nine and half vears' a imprisonment.

been convicted in another offence some time in the

sentence and there appears to be no likelihood of the

appeal being taken up for hearing.

In these circumstances, the petitioners are

appropriate to impose.
