ORDER

Learned counsel for the petitioner, by the instant petition filed under

Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is raising the grievance saying that the petitioner's application for demarcation dated 18.05.2023 is not being decided expeditiously by the revenue authority. She is apprehending that demarcation could not be carried out smoothly because the other party holding the land adjoining to the land of the petitioner are not allowing the revenue authorities to carry out the spot inspection.

However, the documents available on record indicate that the Tahsildar after taking cognizance has proceeded in the matter and as such, this petition is disposed of directing the Tahsildar to expedite the proceeding and conclude the same within a period of three months in accordance with law. It is made clear that while conducting demarcation, if the revenue authorities find any obstruction from the persons holding the land adjoining to the land of the petitioner, in that situation, the revenue authorities shall be free to take assistance from the police authorities.

With the aforesaid, the petition filed by the petitioner stands **disposed of**.

It is made clear that this Court has not expressed on the merits of the case. The Tahsildar will conclude the proceeding after following due procedure of law.
