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ORDER

This petition has been filed seeking the following reliefs:-

- "(i) The petitioner most respectfully prays that this Hon'ble Court may kindly be pleased to: Issue a writ of mandamus directing the Commissioner, to expedite and decide the petitioner's pending appeal within a fixed period (preferably within 15 days) from the date of receipt of this order.
(ii) Direct the Collector, District Khandwa, to forthwith transmit the complete original record of the externment proceedings to the appellate authority within 7 days.
(iii) The hon'ble court may be pleased to pass any other order in favour of petitioner to which this hon'ble deems fit."

At the outset, it is submitted that the petitioner has filed an appeal which is pending consideration before the respondent No.2. An innocuous prayer is made to direct the authority to consider and decide the pending appeal expeditiously.

Learned State counsel appearing for the respondents/State has no objection to the innocuous prayer of the petitioner.

Under these circumstances, this petition is disposed off directing the



respondent No.2 to consider and decide the pending appeal of the petitioner within a period of 45 days from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

Needless to mention that this Court has not expressed any opinion on the merit of the case.
